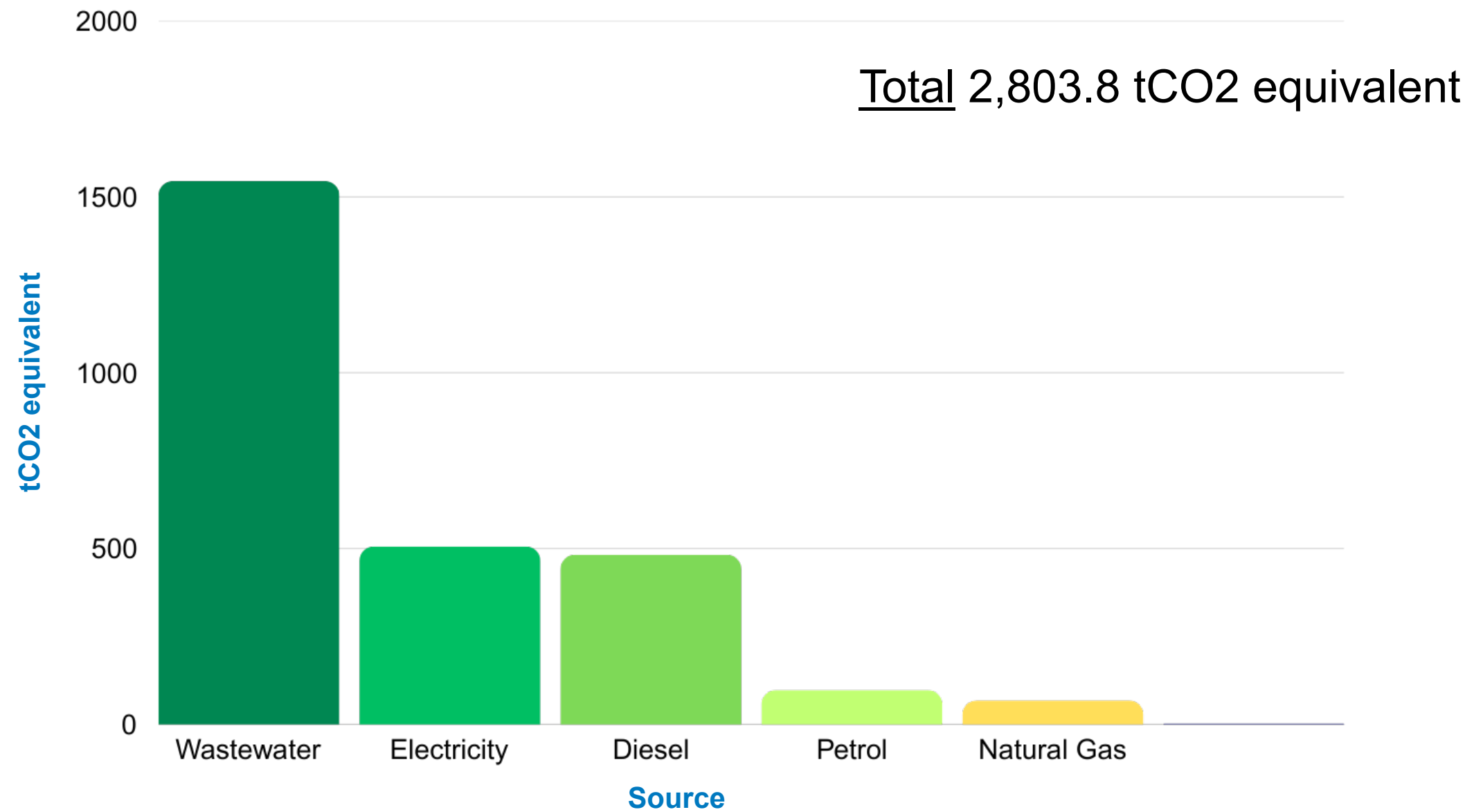

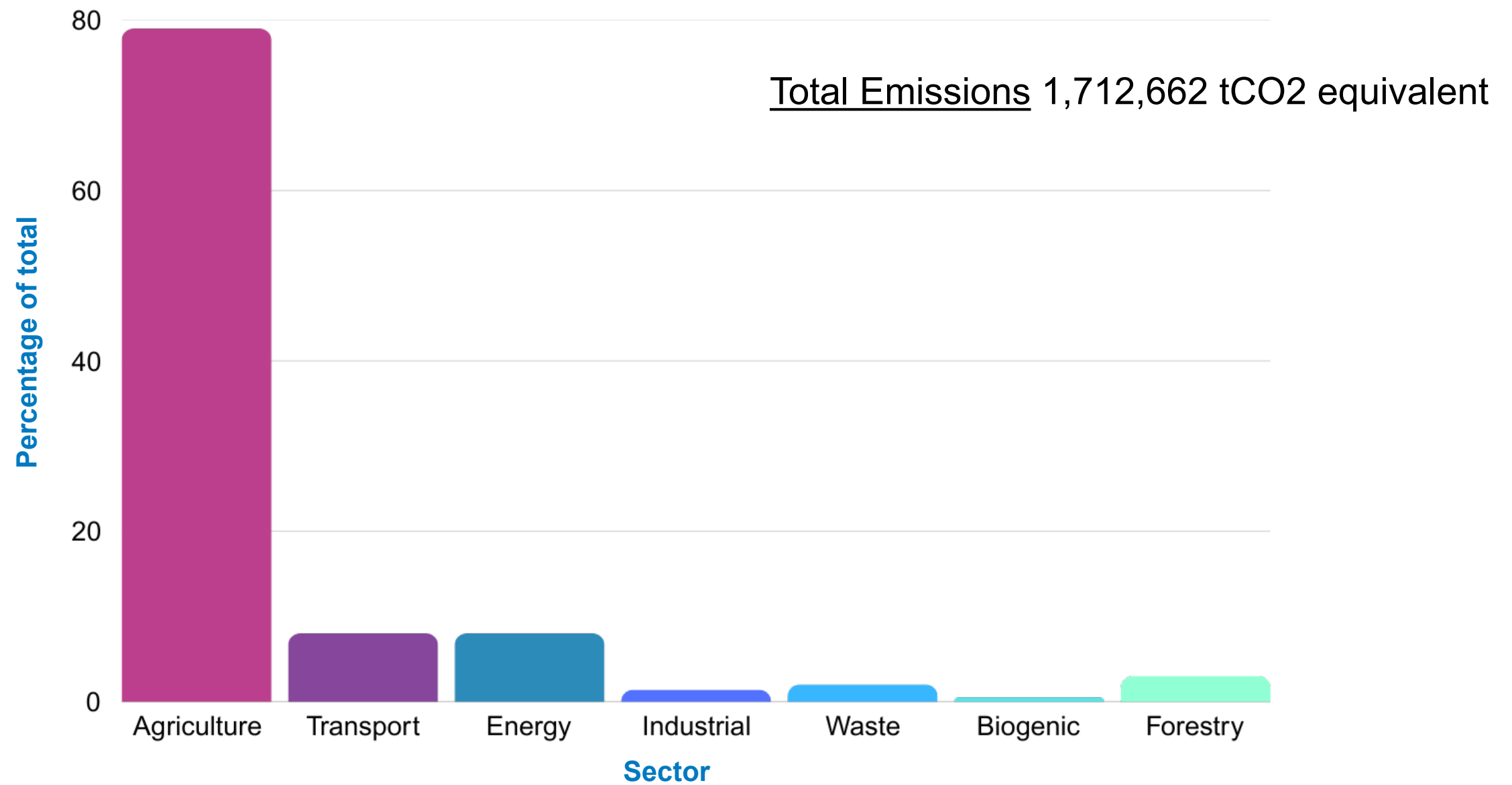

Example messaging - Smokefree Outdoor Spaces, Happier Places



- **Key Message: Promote Council's Policy and smoke/vape free areas**
- Council's policy supports smokefree areas in town centres, parks, and public facilities.
- Benefits: Less second-hand smoke exposure, cleaner public spaces, healthier environments for tamariki and whānau.
- We'll be sharing posts in the lead up to World Smokefree Day



Example messaging - Protecting Tamariki



- **Key Message: Second-hand smoke affects tamariki more than adults.**
- Smoke lingers – even outdoors, harming young lungs.
- Keeping our parks and playgrounds smokefree makes a real difference.
- Lets support our tamariki’s health and lead by example.
- Could include a video from tamariki/rangatahi perspective.



Example messaging - Smokefree means vape free too



- **Key Message: Council's policy covers both smoking and vaping.**
- Second-hand vape aerosol affects tamariki and people with respiratory conditions.
- Let's keep our shared spaces smoke and vape free!



Example messaging - Enjoy the fresh air this weekend!



- **Key Message: Parks, sport fields, and playgrounds are smokefree and vape free**
- A friendly reminder that these areas are Smokefree and Vape free spaces! Let's keep the air fresh and clean for everyone.
